

BEANS





The beans all lived together in their can.

They were a cozy little clan.






They were as close as kin.

BERT


But their tiny tin

he felt too packed in..


Bert wanted to explore, to make new friends and see more. But the beans didn't agree, they begged Bert to stay with them.



Oh, Bert please don't go




The Veg out there, isn't like us



Where better to be, than with your own kind.



But Bert was a brave bean, and he let the others know, he wouldn't be gone forever, but now was his time to go.




Bert told them, he would find some more friends, it would be worth it. The beans trusted Bert.

Maybe the outside world wasn't that bad, and that made them smile.




Poor Bert plodded

could see.




What the other beans said was sinking in, maybe i'm

bean like me....


...untill he came across a pea!




Bert wondered if they would get along.
