Due to an administrative error the boundary line for the Hartlepool Development Corporation (HDC) has been incorrectly drawn resulting in a

small overlap between the jurisdiction of the HDC and Hartlepool Borough Council as the planning authority.

A planning application has since come forward to develop a site off Maritime Avenue which is predominantly within the HDC. In terms of determining the

planning application, it would be better if this was to be determined by one planning authority rather than a cross

boundary application. Given the

majority of the site sits within the HDC and it was always the intention that this full site rest solely within the HDC boundary, it

is proposed to delegate our

planning function to the HDC to allow them to determine the full $% \left\{ 1,2,\ldots,n\right\}$

application on this occasion.

The Council would still be consulted on any application coming forward through the existing neighbouring authority

arrangements and the principle of

the development was previously agreed under application

H/FUL/0638/01.

Without using this delegation, part a would apply in that the planning application could not be determined in time which would jeopardise a significant amount of external funding being used on this site before the deadline of March 2025. This delegation covers all 7 sites although errors have only been identified on 3 of the sites to date.

Considered & Rejected:

Given the small errors in the boundary drawing, a cross boundary application would not be suitable as the element of HBC area is too small to have an impact on the wider development.
